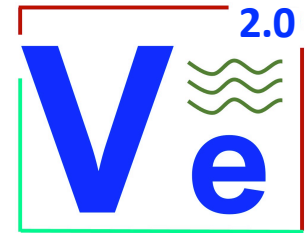


VE 2.0 Quick Reference Guide



Starting VE

ve filename

VE Modes

Insert (default)

Overwrite

Command

Enter Text

Begin typing – VE defaults to text insertion mode

Format Text

ESC-w Wrap paragraph

Esc-o, w Enable on-the-fly text wrapping

Moving Around

Home Move to start of line

End Move to end of line

Cursor Keys Move one row or column

Page Up/Dn Move one screen up/down

Esc-j, l Jump to line number

Esc-z Move line to top of screen

Repeat Last Command

F1 Repeat last command

Esc-a Repeat last command

Repeat Command “n” Times

Esc-n command: repeat “n” times

Esc-* command: repeat until done

Find Text

Esc-f Find text patterns

F5 Find text patterns

Function Keys

F1 Again. Repeat last command

F2 Block. Define, operate on blocks

F3 Unassigned

F4 Jump. Jump to start, end, line number

F5 Find. Find text pattern

F6 Replace. Replace text pattern with another

F7 Paste. Paste last copied line/block

F8 Edit. Edit more or new files, switch files

F9 Delete Line. Kill the current line

F10 Delete Right. Delete to end of line

F11 Update. Save file, return to editing

F12 Quit. Save/Save As/Discard/Quit VE

Edit Multiple Files

Esc-e Edit command

f Edit named file

n Edit new file

m Menu of open files

+ Move to next open file

= Move to next open file

ESC-{ Move to start of paragraph

ESC-} Move to end of paragraph

ALT-Cur Left Move to start of word

ALT-Cur Right Move to end of word

ALT-PgUp Move to start of file

ALT-PgDn Move to end of file

Delete Text

Del Delete char under cursor

Rubout Delete char to left of cursor

ALT-Del Delete word

F9 Delete Line

F10 Delete to end of line

Find and Replace Text

Esc-r Find, replace text patterns

F6 Find, replace text patterns

-v Verify; prompt each replacement
(append “-v” to replace pattern)

Break/Join Lines

Enter Break line into two at cursor

Del End, Delete joins two lines

Rubout Home, Rubout joins two lines

Copy, Paste, Delete, Move Lines

Esc-b, b Copy current line

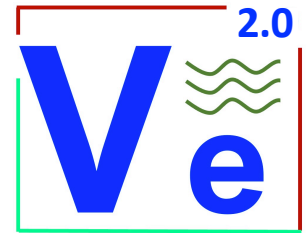
Esc-b, d Delete current line (copies first)

Esc-b, g Get/Paste copied/deleted lines

F7 Paste copied/deleted lines

F9 Kill current line (not copied)

Work with Line Blocks

Esc-b	Block command
Markers	Interactively define block
c	Copy block to buffer
a	Append block to block
d	Delete block (copies to buffer)
g	Paste Block Buffer lines into file
s	Save block or buffer to file
r	Read file into buffer, paste it

VE Options

Esc-o	Options command
t	Set Tab, tabstop options
a	Set auto-indent options
w	Enable/Disable Text Wrapping

Miscellaneous Commands

Esc-v	Redraw screen
ESC-s	VE status

Macros

Esc-m	Macro command
c	Create macro
s	Stop macro creation
l	List all defined macros
e	Execute Macro
x	eXecute Macro
d	Delete macro
s	Save macro to file
r	Read macro from file

Esc-x eXecute Macro

At startup, VE automatically executes any macro found at c:\ve.mac.

Save Your Work and/or Quit VE

F11	Save file to disk
Esc-q	Quit command
s	Save file, discard/move/quit
d	Discard file, move/quit
a	Discard all files, quit
w	Write file out w/ new name
CTL-f	Force Quit (if VE seems stuck)
